- ❖ Near-distance acuity such that the applicant is capable of reading a minimum of Jeager Number 1 or equivalent type and size letters at a distance of not less than 12 inches on a standard Jeager test chart.
- ❖ Reasonably measured gross stereopsis (depth perception).
